I can set my Nikon Df on Manual Mode and Auto ISO. In average room light with a classic 35mm f2 Nikkor Ai-s lens I can set a shutter speed of 1/60 sec and an aperture of f/2.8. ISO fluctuates from around 320 to 640—a very safe range—while the shutter speed and aperture remain as set.
