XIXth century engraving showing Scala Regia. To have an idea of what is behind the Swiss guard we may have a look at this old print. On the right there is a tapestry based on a cartoon by Raphael and after that the statue of the Vision of Emperor Constantine before the Battle of Ponte Milvio by Bernini. This statue and the Scala Regia were printed on the 50.000 Liras note, as shown in the icon at the top of this page (Lira was the Italian currency prior to the move to Euro).

### Scala Regia The Entrance to the Vatican

The Scala Regia, the ceremonial staircase, is one of Bernini's most brilliant concepts. Exploiting the fact that the existing walls within which it had to be inserted were not parallel, he dramatized the perspective effect by making the two rows of ionic columns which flank the staircase converge and gradually diminish in height as they rise.

"The Piazza of St Peter's was built by Bernini for Pope Alexander VII in 1656-67. It was conceived as a grand approach to the church but had to be planned so that the greatest number of people could see the Pope give his blessing, either from the middle of the façade of the church or from a window in the Vatican Palace."

### Piazza of St. Peter's - Bernini - Great Buildings Architecture

The work of art was inaugurated on 30th October 1670 by Clement X Altieri, who wanted it at the foot of the Scala Regia. The astonished Emperor, riding his horse, looks high at the appearance of the cross. Behind the group, an alive drapery in stucco similar to brocade full of gold emphasizes the impetuous movement of the horse.
