Such notations are called in-text citations, and APA format dictates that when citing in APA format in the text of your paper, use the author's name followed by the date of publication. For example, if you were to cite Sigmund Freud's book *The Interpretation of Dreams*, you would use the following format: (Freud, 1900).

APA Format: Basic Rules You Must Follow

If you use exact words from the original, quotation marks are necessary. If you paraphrase or restate the idea in your own words, don't use quotation marks, but document the source. In the APA (American Psychological Association) format, one of several documentation formats, you briefly identify your sources in the text of your paper, then give the full information in the Reference List at the end of the paper.

APA Citing Style

To set up the APA template in Google Docs: Open a new document and select File > New > From template. The template gallery will open in a separate browser tab. If you have read only the electronic form of an article's print version, add [Electronic version] in brackets after the title of the article. If an on-line article has been changed from the print version or has additional information, follow the same general format for the author, date, and ...

If an author is shown on the report, use the author's last name, as in (Gibson, 2012, p. 3). If no author is shown, use the name of the government agency, as in (U.S. Department of Energy, 2012, p. 75).

Government Documents (APA 6th ed.) - Writing Center ...

Treat a government document as a book, report, or brochure. If a person is named on the title page, use her or him as author. If no person is named, use the government agency, department, or branch as a group author. Give the name of the group author exactly as it appears on the title page.

The APA Style provides guidelines on how to cite information from many sources, including websites. Review the website and gather as much information as possible about the site. Make note of the name of the website, title or section used, date of publication, date you retrieved the information and the URL.
