In 1969 Dutch chemist Paul Crutzen published a paper that described the major nitrogen oxide catalytic cycle affecting ozone levels. Crutzen demonstrated that nitrogen oxides can react with free oxygen atoms, thus slowing the creation of ozone (O 3), and can also decompose ozone into nitrogen dioxide (NO 2) and oxygen gas (O 2).

Conclusions: Looking back over the scientific investigation of ozone depletion, we can see how the Molina-Rowland hypothesis evolved with new data. When chlorine nitrate, a chemical that ties up chlorine in an ozone-safe form, was added to the hypothesis, the expected amount of ozone loss decreased.

Conclusions - Science

In the simplest example of such a cycle, a chlorine atom reacts with an ozone molecule (O. 3), taking an oxygen atom to form chlorine monoxide (ClO) and leaving an oxygen molecule (O. 2). The ClO can react with a second molecule of ozone, releasing the chlorine atom and yielding two molecules of oxygen.
