Recommendations for the Treatment of Asian-American ...

Asian culture emphasizes family cohesion and continuity. Use family's care, concern for, and commitment to the individual's well-being as powerful resources. Most Western counseling approaches value individualism; they emphasize direct emotional expressiveness, self responsibility and freedom. It may not be appropriate for Asian clients.

Multicultural Counseling Competencies | Counseling Asian ...

Therapists need to be cognizant that Western psychotherapy may be foreign to Asian immigrants, and that clients may need more time and understanding before they feel comfortable freely expressing themselves in treatment (Hwang, 2006). Asian immigrants may be less culturally inclined to talk about their problems with a person with whom they have not developed a close relationship.
