Inspect the fuel pump visually. If fuel is dripping, the diaphragm is faulty and you need a new pump. Detach the fuel line from the carburetor and put it in an empty container. Crank the engine and watch how the fuel flows from the line.

When the mechanical fuel pump leaks oil from a silicone gasket, the cause can often be traced back to improperly tightened pump mounting bolts. The fuel pump bolt torque specification is usually around 25 to 35 foot-pounds. Regardless of the model of the fuel pump, the best way to ensure the bolt is tightened properly is to use a torque wrench.

All electric pumps push fuel far better than they can pull (suck) fuel. Make sure that a low restriction filter is between the tank and the pump. A 40-micron element is sufficient to protect the pump from contamination such as dirt, rust, fuel cell foam, etc. Mallory has them available that will screw directly into the pump itself.
